May is finally here and the Auxiliary has a few things going on. May 24th is National Poppy Day. The red poppy is a nationally recognized symbol of sacrifice worn by Americans since World War I to honor those who served and died for our country in all wars. On May 24, wear a red poppy to honor the fallen and support the living who have worn our nation's uniform. We will be passing out poppies Memorial Day weekend. (Watch for an email with info as to how you can help.) Also, we will have poppies and donation canisters out at the Post. If you work where we would be able to place our poppies & canisters, please let me know. Our poppy money is used strictly for veterans. We are currently working with the Post Service Officer, Greg Vassilious, in assisting a veteran.

Flags are put out on the graves of veterans in the Kennesaw Cemetery on Friday, May 24th. If you are available to assist with the flags, please be there at 9 a.m. On Memorial Day, the 27th, the Kennesaw Cemetery has a ceremony in which the Legion family participates. The Auxiliary passes out poppies and one member will read a poem. Please volunteer for this meaningful service, whether passing out poppies or reading the poem. (Contact me if you are interested in reading the poem.) The ceremony starts at 7 p.m., so you need to be there between 6:15-6:30.

Elections for the Auxiliary will be held at the May meeting. I encourage you to attend the meeting and to consider one of our leadership positions. Positions include: President; 1st Vice-President (fills in when the President is absent); 2nd Vice-President (Membership Chair); Secretary; Treasurer; Chaplain; Sgt. At Arms. T-Shirts, Polo Shirts and Lapel Pins Now Available

With the creation of our new logo, the Post is now making available for purchase t-shirts, polo shirts and lapel pins. We have created PRE-ORDER forms that you need to fill out so we know how many items to order. Once we reach a minimum number for each item, we will place the order and then you will be responsible for paying for your order once it arrives.

We will be taking orders for the first batch up through the next General Meeting on May 16th. To obtain an order form, Stop by the Post and pick up order forms at the bar.

Lapel pins are 1" x 1" and will have 2 military-style pins on the back to hold them in place. Price is **\$6 per pin.**

Polo shirts are **\$25 each** for S,M,L and XL, and \$27 for 2XL or \$28 for 3XL.

Please note on the form that by signing it, you are committing to paying for your order. It will take approximately 3-4 weeks for delivery once the batch orders are placed after May 16th.
