Queen of Hearts Progressive 50/50 Raffle

Objective: To raise money for Post 304 projects, equipment, charities, music, etc...

Who: Post 304 Family Members

When: Sunday evening drawing at 6:30pm, 1st drawing on Sunday, Oct 3rd

1. The Queen of Hearts progressive raffle utilizes a Queen of Hearts manufacturer's raffle board. The board has been developed specifically for this Raffle Game and has 54 sealed, numbered cards. Under the sealed cards resides a randomly placed deck of poker cards with two Jokers.

2. Current Commander cannot participate and will draw the ticket each week. In the event the Commander cannot be present, a Present Officer of the Post will draw.

3. Raffle tickets will be on sale daily and stop at 5:30pm on Sunday to allow for counting of funds and prepare for the drawing.

4. Only the bartenders, Officers of the Post or designated representatives can sell tickets.

5. Purchased tickets will go in the tumbler. Tickets must be mixed in Public View prior to each drawing.

6. Purchasers full name and phone number need to be written on the back of each ticket.

7. If you are not going to be present at the drawing, you must declare a numbered card from the board and write the number on your Raffle ticket stub.

8. Tickets cannot be bent, folded, stickered, etc... and may be disqualified if so.

9. There is no limit on number of tickets purchased.

10. Donations per ticket:

- **10.1.** Pot amount \$500 to \$2000 \$2 (6 for \$10)
- **10.2.** Pot amount \$2001 to \$5000 \$3 (6 for \$15)
- **10.3.** Pot amount \$5001 and over \$5 (6 for \$25)

11. Pay Out - Each new pot will start at \$500:

- **11.1.** Queen of Hearts %50 of total Jackpot.
- **11.2.** The Post receives the other 50% to go into the General Post Fund.
- **11.3.** Joker \$50
- **11.4.** Queen of Spades/Clubs/Diamonds = \$25
- **11.5.** Weekly Drawn Ticket winner = \$20

12. If the Queen of Hearts is not drawn, the pot rolls over to the next week.

13. The pot will continue to build until the Queen of Hearts is drawn; this could take up to 54 weeks.

14. Once the Queen of Hearts is drawn, the game stops and new raffle will begin.

15. The organization running the Raffle will withhold all taxes from winnings where applicable. You will be required to provide proper identification and information for taxes. All tickets and monies will be accounted for by the organization's designated person in accordance with all rules and regulations.

16. Any member winning more than \$600 will be required to fill out and sign appropriate tax forms.

17. You <u>must be a current paid member</u> of the Post 304 American Legion, Auxiliary, Sons of the American Legion or American Legion Riders group to participate. Membership must be verified prior to payout.

18. Junior members under the age of 18, Family and visitors/guests cannot participate.

19. Members of another post cannot participate.

20. All tickets are disposed of after each weekly drawing.
